CONDEMNATION ORDER OF STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD FIXING COMPENSATION
TO BE PAID FOR THE TAKING OF LAND AND RIGHTS THEREIN IN THE
TOWN OF COLCHESTER

In accordance with Chapter 5 of Title 19, Vermont Statutes Annotated, and Chapter 55 of Title 3, Vermont Statutes Annotated, and in accordance with the Notice of Hearing dated August 3, 1994, after hearing duly held at the Agency of Transportation, Special Projects Unit Office on August 23, 1994, the State Transportation Board at the time and place of hearing examined the premises, heard the parties interested in the land therein described regarding compensation, and has fixed the compensation to be awarded as follows:

The land and premises being acquired by this order must be vacated and possession given up to the State Transportation Board on the date of filing of this order with the Town Clerk of the Town in which said land and premises are located. Improved properties must be vacated within 90 days of written notice of this order. These requirements may be revised by agreement between the condemnees and the Agency of Transportation.

Any owner or interested person, affected by this order, who is dissatisfied with the amount of damages awarded by the State Transportation Board as set forth in this order may, within ninety days after the date this order is filed with the Town Clerk, institute an appeal by a Petition in writing to the Chittenden Superior Court and will be entitled to a hearing or a trial by jury if desired.

For further information of premises and rights acquired by this order reference is hereby made to plans of Highway Project Colchester IR 089-3(11) as filed in the office of the Clerk of the Town of Colchester or any revisions thereto subsequently filed therein.
