WARRANTY DEED

Being part of the same land and premises conveyed to Kenneth G. and Valerie B. Mathieu by Warranty Deed of Raymond Parizo dated November 20, 1975 and recorded in Book 122, Page 390 of the land records of the Town of Essex. The interest of Valerie B. Mathieu was conveyed to Kenneth G. Mathieu by Quit Claim Deed dated August 22, 1979 and recorded in Book 149, Page 121 of the land records of the Town of Essex. And being more particularly described as follows:

Being parcel 0413A&B, consisting of .26 Acres, more or less, with building, and;
